1.0 NOTIFICATION

The Columbia Police Department may be called upon by correctional institutes or juvenile justice facilities to provide assistance during riots, disasters, or other emergency situations.

In the event of an emergency situation at any of the Department of Corrections facilities that requires outside assistance, the institutional head will notify the Columbia-Richland Communications Center. The Communications Center will notify the Watch Commander of the situation and dispatch available patrol units.

2.0 DEPLOYMENT OF POLICE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL

The Watch Commander will serve as the Police Department Incident Commander and shall be briefed by Department of Corrections' personnel and will determine the assignment of City of Columbia Police Officers during the event.

The main responsibilities of the Police Department will be:

- Secure the area outside the fenced area. This includes preventing individuals from trying to enter the facility as well as escaping from the facility.
- Control vehicular and pedestrian traffic outside the facility.

COLUMBIA POLICE DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES ARE PROHIBITED FROM ENTERING THE CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE AND CORRECTION FACILITY OFFICIALS.
